# STCL-GEN-015 (JA1) EMMES System AdvantageEDC<sup>SM</sup>

- 1. There shall be a system to limit access to authorized individuals.
- 2. Individuals making entries shall be identifiable.
- 3. JavaScript Error Messages
  - 3.1. If the system suddenly becomes unresponsive and beeps when the mouse is clicked there is a buried JavaScript error.
  - 3.2. Press Alt+F4 (PC) or Command-W (Macintosh) to close the browser.
  - 3.3. Then a JavaScript error box should appear
  - 3.4. Write down as much of the error message as possible (or capture as a print screen and paste it in a Word or Word Perfect document and e-mail it as an attachment to the Quality Department.
  - 3.5. Any unsaved data will be lost, when this error occurs.
  - 3.6. Then click [OK].
  - 3.7. Restart the browser to resume data entry.
- 4. The EMMES Corporation will maintain all Java Script Error reports and the resolution for each error message they received.
- 5. Assignment and Maintenance of User IDs and Passwords
  - 5.1. The AdvantageEDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator protects patient identity, medical information confidentiality and data entry integrity by requiring users of the online data entry system to enter a unique user ID and password prior to system entry.
  - 5.2. The AdvantageEDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator is responsible for the maintenance and assignment of user IDs and passwords.
    - 5.2.1. The AdvantageEDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator has the ability to limit a user's access to "Read" or "Read/Write".
  - 5.3. Requirements for Assigning User IDs and Passwords
    - 5.3.1. Receive request from client to add a new user to system
    - 5.3.2. Determine level of access to be granted to the new user

- 5.3.3. Advantage EDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator sends the User ID and password to the client via email (user ID and password are not sent in the same email as the data entry URL)
- 5.3.4. Advantage EDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator documents the new user's name, user ID and password, access limitations and date.
- 6. Stem cell laboratory data base
  - 6.1. Assignment and Maintenance of User IDs and Password
    - 6.1.1. The STCL database administrator protects patient identity, medical information confidentiality and data entry integrity by requiring users of the online data entry system to enter a unique user ID and password prior system entry.
    - 6.1.2. The STCL database administrator is responsible for the maintenance and assignment of user IDs and passwords.
    - 6.1.3. The STCL Advantage EDC<sup>SM</sup> database administrator has the ability to limit a user's access to "Read" or "Read/Write".
  - 6.2. Requirements for Assigning User IDs and Passwords
    - 6.2.1. STCL database administrator determines the level of access to be granted to the new user when utilizing the STCL database.
    - 6.2.2. Data entry rights are granted based on the employee's job functions/responsibilities.
    - 6.2.3. User name and password are established for each employee requiring access to the database. This information is communicated to the employee via e-mail.
    - 6.2.4. STCL database administrator documents the new user's name, user ID and password, access limitations and date.
- 7. Advantage EDC<sup>SM</sup> User's Guide
  - 7.1. This document explains the basic procedures for performing data entry over the Internet using Advantage EDC<sup>SM</sup>. This User's Guide provides information on accessing the software and entering data. Illustrations of the data entry screens, navigation bars, and system-warning messages are included throughout the User's Guide.
